### Accident Investigators Elected to Key Slots

The International Society of Air Safety Investigators (ISASI) has elected two long-time ALPA air safety activists and accident investigators to key positions of leadership.

During its 1994 election of officers and councillors in September, ISASI elected Capt. Richard B. Stone (Delta, Ret.) as president and Capt. James A. McIntyre (TWA, Ret.) as U.S. councillor. ~~Both~~ will serve a two-year term (1994-1996).

Capt. Stone, the former ALPA Executive Chairman for Aeromedical Resources, received an ALPA Presidential Citation in 1992 for his years of contributions to air safety.

Capt. McIntyre received the 1985 ALPA Air Safety Award, the Association's highest award given to a line pilot for volunteer air safety work.
