I am especially interested in Public Law 93-545, which corrected the inequity in retirement credit and longevity pay in 1974. I was discharged from the Navy in August of 1948. In March of 1949 I entered active duty in the USAF as a Chaplain, 1st LT. At first, the Air Force gave me pay credit for my three years in the Navy. Then after a number of months, they took away my Midshipman time for longevity and collected all the overpayment. I retired in 1983 from the USAF, but never did receive longevity pay for my Midshipman service.

Have there been other cases as mine and can anything be done after all these years? It would be interesting to find out, and I would appreciate any information you can give me.
